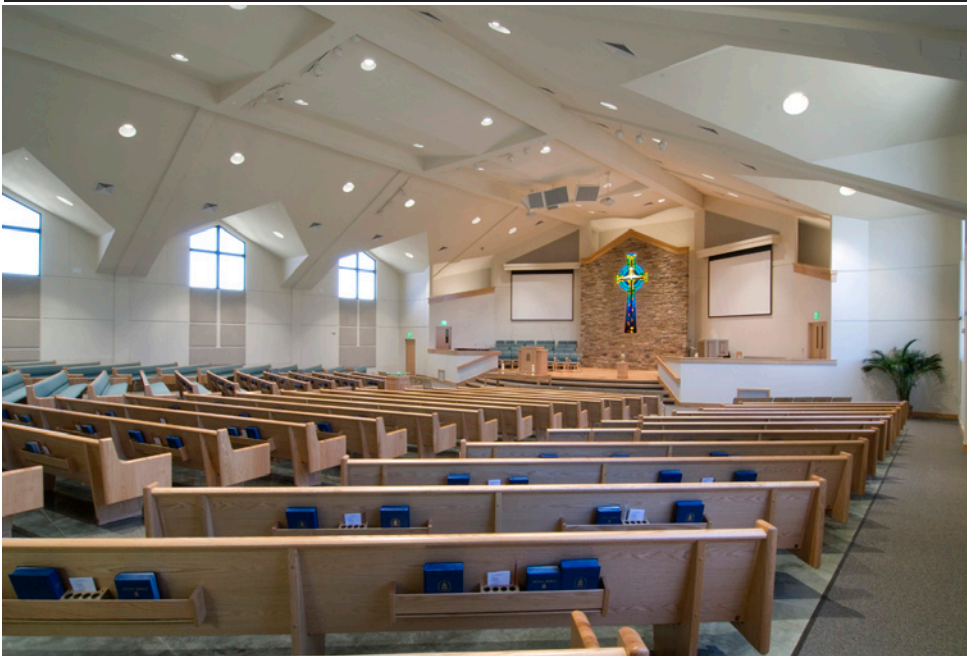




PINE RIDGE PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH



Mantel Teter Architects worked with the building committee and various ministry groups in the church through a series of programming workshops to determine the vision of the church and creating of the church's new campus master plan. A written program with a site analysis, feasibility study, and financial models were provided.

We assisted the church in developing a plan based on the prioritization of needs. We identified three major areas of concern: provide a new church facility that includes all existing church amenities, bring the new and old together through the language of architecture, and adhere to the established budget.

Mantel Teter Architects created conceptual floor plans, elevations, and three-dimensional models to address these areas of concern and communicate the design for the project. We also made several congregational presentations of the drawings at various phases of completion to ensure good communication. Additionally, our firm assisted the church's fund raising consultant with visual aids and graphic design for use in their promotional materials.
